## **Key Scriptures**

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- Have you ever been so focused on a problem that you were blinded from truth? How did you start seeing God again?
- Is there a situation in your life that feels hopeless right now? Talk about this with your group. What would it look like to lift your eyes to Him?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

Father, You are El Roi. You see every single one of us right where we are. Please give us the comfort that You promise us in Scripture, and remind us of the comfort we've experienced personally from You in the past. Remind us that You are near and that You want us to draw near to You. In Jesus' name, amen.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
